Will it Felt?

To test a fibre to see if it will felt before beginning all that hard work, do the following.

Ingredients:

- 1. White King Bleach NO LEMON, use plain White King
- 2. Small glass jar with lid
- 3. 10" lengths of the fibre to be tested.

Method:

- 1. Half fill the small jar with White King Bleach
- 2. Cut 10" lengths of fibre and fold in half in a bundle
- 3. Put the folded end of the bundle into the bleach and screw on the lid, leave the tails hanging out
- 4. Note it may start to bubble and colour, this is normal, don't worry.
- 5. Leave for 30 minutes.
- 6. Remove the threads and lay out on paper towel

Results:

- 1. Some threads will dissolve and break in half, these are FELT'ABLE
- 2. Some threads will remain intact, in the main these will NOT FELT.
- 3. Some threads will be middling, these will felt but will be difficult to felt.

Well done, enjoy felting your fibres.

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
